Proclamation

- WHEREAS,** the “Sandwich Generation” is defined as those caring for their children as well as their own aging parents, and with (according to the Pew Research Center) just over 1 of every 8 Americans aged 40 to 60 both raising a child and caring for a parent, in addition to between 7 to 10 million adults caring for their aging parents from a long distance; and
- WHEREAS,** U.S. Census Bureau statistics indicate that the number of older Americans aged 65 or older will double by the year 2030, to over 70 million; and
- WHEREAS,** the great State of Louisiana has an active, productive Sandwich Generation population; and
- WHEREAS,** communities throughout the United States will be both commemorating and celebrating the month of July as a tribute to the dedication, patience and caring of adults who are part of the Sandwich Generation.
- NOW, THEREFORE,** I, Bobby Jindal, Governor of the State of Louisiana, do hereby proclaim July 2009 as
