WHEREAS, According to the Pew Research Center, more than one in eight Americans aged 40 to 60 are currently part of the Sandwich Generation; and


WHEREAS, United States Census Bureau statistics indicate that the number of Americans age 65 or older will double to more than 70 million by the year 2030; and
